EDITORS

Editors are responsible for reviewing each manuscript and for evaluating them in a given time frame.

- 1. To ensure that the publication house maintains the best quality while adhering to the publication rules and procedures of the journal.
- 2. To promote the journal at conferences and meetings.
- 3. To contribute Editorial Articles in their subject expertise.
- 4. To suggest and review the special issues as well as conference papers whenever required.
- 5. Systematic evaluation of the review reports, hold vital decision on paper acceptance or rejection.
- 6. Decision to accept/ reject or make changes in paper.
- 7. To work with other Editorial Board Members to increase the impact of the Journal.
- 8. To suggest /guide the reviewers on how to improve the impact factor and other various factors required to enhance the quality of the Journal.
